#### **Lunch filet mignon at Del Frisco's Grille**

Lunch at the Fort Worth location of this steakhouse with outposts in Southlake and Dallas is a prime opportunity to enjoy a luxurious piece of beef (pictured above). Clocking in at a midday-friendly six ounces, it's served with a seasonable vegetable and roasted garlic mashed potatoes or crispy frites.

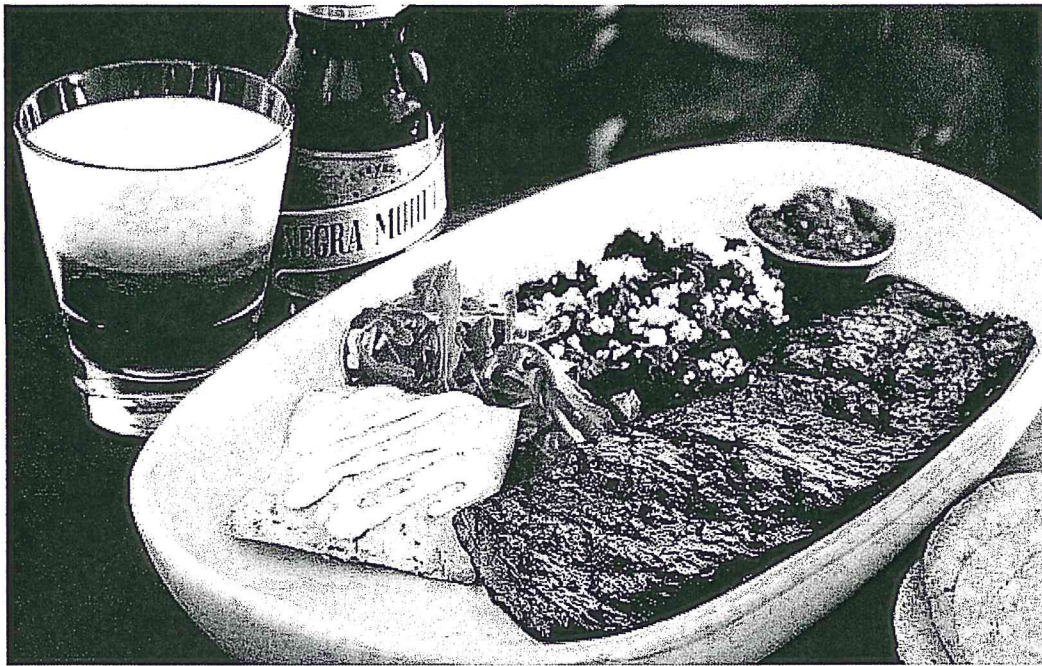

#### **Lunch NY strip at Dakota's**

Head underground at this Downtown steakhouse where a generous 10-ounce New York strip can be procured at lunchtime. Seasoned simply with sea salt and fresh ground black pepper, it's brushed with garlic butter and served with mashed potatoes and green beans.

**Carne asada at Meso Maya**

Pop over to this North Dallas interior Mexican favorite any time of day for a melt-in-your-mouth steak with south-of-the-border flair. A wood-fired marinated steak (pictured above) is perfectly seasoned and served with a homemade sweet corn tamal, crema Mexicana, charred tomato salsa, queso fresco and black beans.

**Lunch filet mignon at Kenny's Wood Fired Grill**

This Addison hot spot for American fare has a delectable six-ounce filet mignon on its lunch menu. Wood grilled, it's topped with a Roquefort bacon butter and served atop a rich port demi. Includes a choice of side (adult mac 'n' cheese being a guest favorite).
